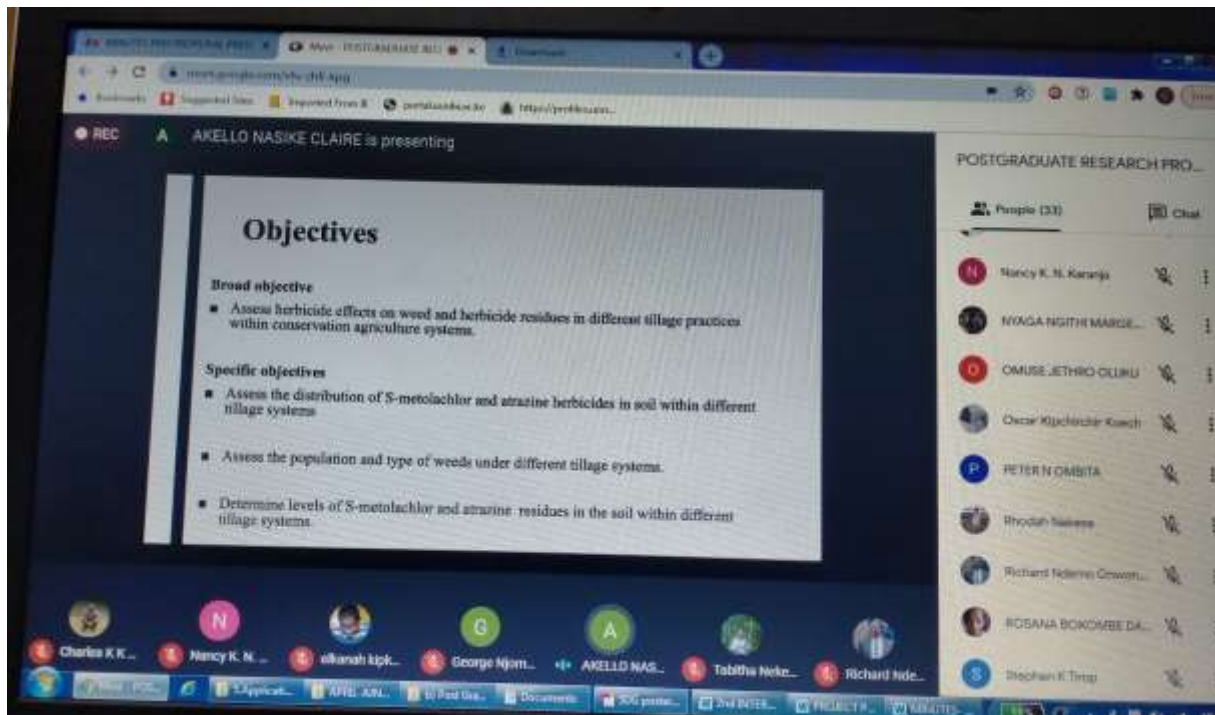


MASTER YOUR RESEARCH; STUDENTS PROPOSAL PRESENTATION
