


## POST GRADUATE PRESENTATIONS

## Objective 3

- Goats/sheep are followed by two researchers and samples taken early morning and afternoon.
- The forage species' name that the lactating sheep/goat spends more than 10 minutes is recorded
- The feed is cut using a scissor to mimic grazing/foraging. The cut browse, forb or grass is collected and the sample stored in a carbon paper.
- 140 nannies and ewes are selected for milk records on a weekly basis .
