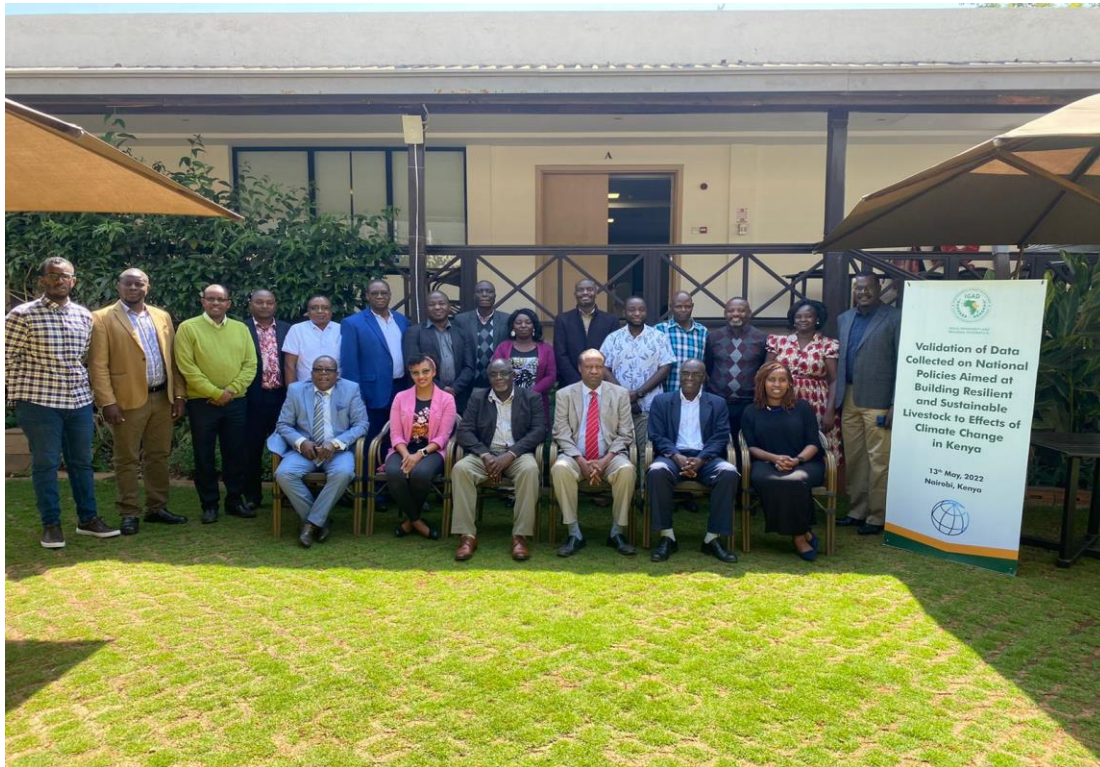


Validation workshop on national policies and programmes aimed at building resilient and sustainable livestock to effects of climate change in Kenya
